

Giving Hope and Help celebrates successful feminine product drive

Giving Hope and Help recently collected more than 40,000 products during its feminine hygiene products drive.

In addition to collecting more than 40,000 sanitary napkins and tampons, thousands of toiletries were donated including, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, hair care products, lotion, bar soap, dental care, grooming products, 100 skin care packets of Mary Kay products, more than 50 pair of brand new shoes, 100 pair of underwear, socks and 100 handmade crocheted scarves.

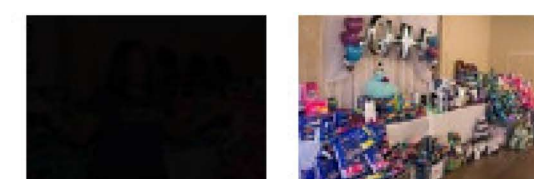
The three shelters that Giving Hope and Help supports — Hope House, SAFEHOME, and Newhouse — were present during the drive. Newhouse was able to take their portion of donations with them from the drive. Giving Hope and Help donated 10,621 sanitary napkins and tampons to Newhouse Shelter in addition to more than 200 additional toiletries, the equivalent of \$5,000.
