KC-area nonprofit donated 40,000 feminine hygiene products to women in 2017

A KC nonprofit continued its tradition of giving in 2017 by donating tens of thousands of feminine hygiene products to domestic violence shelters.

Giving Hope & Help, which was founded in 2013, also donated \$10,000 worth of products to the shelters. It donated about 40,000 sanitary napkins, tampons and toiletries to shelters in Kansas City and surrounding states.

Donations are still being accepted through Dec. 31.
